The Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department is once again sponsoring a Fall Hunter Safety Program. This course is fully certified by the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Department of Maine. The objective is to familiarize youngsters and adults with safety ethics. The course is open to ages 10 and up. Participants 12 years old or younger **must** be accompanied by a parent/guardian; participants 13 - 16 years old are encouraged to have their parents attend classes with them. Parents are welcome and encouraged to register for the course also. The Hunter Safety course will include three classes with instruction covering the following topics:

1. Orientation and Proper Gun Handling
2. Hunter Responsibility
3. Map and Compass
4. Survival and Self-help First Aid
5. Rifles
6. Shot Guns
7. Landowner Relations & Ethics

Attendance at all classes is mandatory. A passing score on the test will be required before certification. Instructors are certified by the State of Maine Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. A variety of teaching techniques will be used by the instructors including films, lecture, **home** textbook study, demonstration, and active participation by students. Upon successful completion, a certificate will be awarded and your name will be reported to the Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. Fee for the course is \$5.00 for all participants. The course will be held on the following dates: Thursdays, **September 8, 22 & 29 from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m.** All materials and literature will be supplied. No firearms or ammunition may be brought into the classroom.

Register at the Brunswick Recreation Center, 30 Federal Street. Office hours are Monday - Friday, 8 am to 4:30 pm. For more information call, 725-6656. Visit us online at www.brunswickme.org/parkrec. **Class size is limited to 40 persons, first come, first served.** A minimum of 15 is needed to hold the class.

NOTE A State of Maine law requires all first time adult hunters (16 years and older) take this certification course before they are issued a license. Anyone younger than 16 can use this certification when they reach 16 years of age.
