****Regulation 2010 A.S.A. 12" Slow Pitch Softball Rules are in effect****

ROSTERS: Please submit your league rosters by May 21, 2010. A.S.A. State Championship play rosters will not be accepted.

LIABILITY: All teams, umpires, officials, and players who participate in this Tournament do so at their own risk.

PROTEST COMMITTEE: A Protest Committee will be set up by the Tournament Director consisting of Tournament Officials present or appointed representatives.

FIELD RULES: Team bench areas / dugouts are limited to players, managers, coaches and a scorer. All must be in uniform and listed on the team roster, with the exception of the Scorer.

- **Smoking or other tobacco use will not be permitted on the playing field or bench area.**
- **Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted on the field, bench areas or parking lots. (Maine law prohibits the consumption of alcoholic beverages on public property.)**
- Batting practice will not be permitted.
- Games will not be held up to allow teams to take infield practice.

UNIFORMS: Pants shall be similar in color. Team shirts shall be the same color and numbered. Tournament officials, in consultation with the umpire-in-chief, shall rule on any uniform issues.

For player safety, shoes with metal cleats are not permitted.

LOCAL INFORMATION

1. Fields are dragged, lined, and watered daily by our full-time maintenance staff.
2. Softball fields are fenced.
3. A.S.A. umpires
4. A limited number of tournament T-shirts will be available for purchase at concession stands.
5. Playground area for children at Edwards Field.
6. Concession area is conveniently located with a variety of foods and beverages.
7. Rest rooms available at all sites.
8. Four, well-maintained softball diamonds in wooded park-like setting.
9. Ample parking and seating areas.

Tournament is limited to thirty-two teams. Applications will be taken on a first paid, first served basis. Teams will be notified when the tournament brackets are finalized.
