Total Course = 6 Hours

Proper Operation & Safety (Boating Handling-Equipment-Trailing) = 3 Hours

Laws = 30 Minutes

Emergencies & Survival (cold water) = 40 Minutes

Self Help First Aid = 20 Minutes

Environment/Ethics = 1 1/2 Hours
