VOTER REGISTRATION APPEALS BOARD***

Board Composition.

The Voter Registration Appeals Board consists of three (3) members, who are appointed by the Town Council. The municipal committees of the major political parties nominate two (2) members and the Town Clerk nominates the third member, the Chair of the Board.

Terms of Office.

The term of office for the members nominated by the major political parties is three (3) years. The Chair's term is four (4) years.

Meeting Schedule.

No set schedule – meet when needed to hear a voter registration appeal.

Powers and Duties.

Upon receipt of a complaint by a person aggrieved by the decision of the Registrar, the Chair of the Registration Appeals Board shall immediately fix a time and place for the board to meet for a prompt hearing. After hearing, the board may affirm, modify or reverse the decision of the Registrar of Voters. The aggrieved person may appeal the decision of the board to the Superior Court in accordance with Rule 80B of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

A Registration Appeals Board may only act by unanimous or majority action.
