

**BRUNSWICK TOWN COUNCIL MINUTES
APRIL 18, 2000
MUNICIPAL MEETING FACILITY**

Councilor Wilson moved, Councilor Dotts seconded, to enter into executive session to discuss appraisals on property. The motion carried with six (6) yeas.

7:30 P.M. Chair McCausland called the meeting to order and asked for the Pledge to the Flag.

Councilors Present: Chair McCausland, Michael Feldman, Eleanor Swanson, Robert Galloupe, Timothy Dotts and Clement Wilson.

Others Present: Donald Gerrish, Town Manager; Melissa L. Smith, Deputy Town Clerk; Jerry Hinton, Police Chief; two selectmen (Dave Chipman and George Swallow) from the Town of Harpswell; Paul Bird, Harpswell Town Administrator; several citizens, members of the press and TV video crew.

Minutes of Previous Meeting: Councilor Dotts moved, Councilor Wilson seconded to accept the minutes from the April 3, 2000 meeting as distributed. The motion carried with six (6) yeas.

Manager's Report:

- 1. Recognition of Chief Hinton being appointed to the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy.** Manager Gerrish congratulated Chief Jerry Hinton on being appointed by Governor King to the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy.
- 2. Recognition of Monica Kincaid for receiving the 2000 Silent Hero Award.** Ms. Kincaid was recognized for her outstanding work, attention to detail, and communications skills. She was instrumental in resolving an armed robbery and the recovery of a substantial amount of stolen property. Chief Hinton expressed his appreciation for Ms. Kincaid.

- 69. The Town Council will consider the one-year reappointment of Alan Houston as Harbor Master from 5/1/2000-4/30/2001 and take any appropriate action.**

Councilor Swanson moved, Councilor Feldman seconded, to reappoint Alan Houston as Harbor Master from 5/1/2000-4/30/2001. The motion carried with six (6) yeas.

- 70. The Town Council will consider setting a public hearing to amend the Traffic and Vehicles Ordinance (Section 15-78) relative to Handicapped Parking Only and take any appropriate action.**

Councilor Feldman moved, Councilor Dotts seconded, to set a public hearing on May 1, 2000 to consider proposed amendments to the Traffic and Vehicles Ordinance (Section 15-78) relative to Handicapped Parking Only. The motion carried with six (6) yeas.

- 71. The Town Council will consider setting a public hearing to amend the Traffic and Vehicles Ordinance (Section 15-78) relative to No Parking Areas on Maine Street and take any appropriate action.**

Councilor Galloupe moved, Councilor Dotts seconded, to set a public hearing on May 1, 2000 to consider proposed amendments to the Traffic and Vehicles Ordinance (Section 15-78) relative to No Parking Areas on Maine Street. The motion carried with six (6) yeas.

72. The Town Council will consider approving Municipal Quitclaim Deeds and take any appropriate action.

Manager Gerrish explained that these four (4) quitclaim deeds are for properties the Town had taken through the lien process. The owners have recently paid all the back taxes, therefore, Mr. Gerrish requested that the Council authorize these deeds to be issued back to the original owners of the properties.

Councilor Feldman moved, Councilor Dotts seconded, to approve the Municipal Quitclaim Deeds for Bruce W. Barrett (2 deeds), Robert T. Coffin II, and Maplewood Homes (filed in the name of Richard Brooks). The motion carried with six (6) yeas.

73. The Town Council will conduct an informal workshop with the Selectmen from the Town of Harpswell and take any appropriate action.

The Town Council held an informal workshop with two Selectmen from the Town of Harpswell, David Chipman, and George Swallow, as well as the Town Administrator Paul Bird. Some items of discussion were Joint Water Quality Consideration at Middle Bay, Mutual Law enforcement, Public Safety Route, Winter Maintenance Routes, and the Family Motor Coach Association, as well as other mutual interests.
