1. Introductions/Public Comment

2. Presentation of 11/28/11 Meeting Summary

3. CSS Workshop Draft Concepts/Recommendations Presentation

- Chair Knight presented draft concepts and recommendations generated through the CSS Workshop. Related comments and requests by topic from Committee members are as follows:
 - **Amenities:**
 - 1) Need uniformity in placement of protruding flags or signs, and sandwich signs throughout the downtown.
 - 2) Make sure Town removes regulatory barriers for sidewalk activity.
 - 3) Issue remains on Outer Pleasant Street regarding barriers to sidewalk usage by adjacent businesses.
 - **Inner Pleasant Street as 2-Way:** Would help delivery truck drivers leaving town.
 - **Maine Street Opportunities:**
 - 1) Back-in angle parking would work well with center median.
 - 2) Concern with narrow and back-in angle parking safety.
 - 3) Highest priority should be bump-outs for pedestrian at crosswalk.
 - 4) Bike lane adjacent to sidewalk preferred.
 - **Committee Requests:**
 - 1) Request CSS Team to recommend high impact/low cost options.
 - 2) Accident data for past 10 years (Maine and Pleasant Streets corridors)
