DATE: October 30, 2013

RE: Proposed connector road at Cook's Corner

The adopted Capital Improvement Plan includes the planning and construction of a connector road from Route 24 (Gurnet Road) across to the Thomas Point Road and then another segment from Thomas Point Road to Tibbett's Drive.

The CIP also identifies some of the funding for this project to be funded out of reserves. The so-called Big Box impact fees are the reserve funds that are recommended for this project.

I am bringing this subject to the Council to discuss the next steps in the project. I would like the Council to authorize staff to seek proposals for the design work for this road and subsequently would be seeking an appropriation from the impact fees to fund the design work.

When this project is fully designed and authorized, we would expect to fund the project with TIF funds, either from the existing Industrial Park TIF or the adoption of a new TIF for this project area. There are advantages to either approach and we will provide the Council with information on both options at the appropriate time.
