

## Public Hearing

The Brunswick Marine Resource Committee will conduct a public hearing at their regularly scheduled meeting on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at 7:00 p.m., at the Municipal Meeting Facility 85 Union Street, to consider enacting the **Thomas Point Beach Conservation Closure** and replacing it with the following.

Effective May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015 to a future date to be determined, for the purpose of resource conservation, it shall be unlawful to dig, take or possess any Soft-Shell Clams (*Mya arenaria*), Quahogs (*Mercenaria mercenaria*), and American and European Oyster taken from all shores, flats, and coastal waters of the New Meadows River, Brunswick, Cumberland County, within an area described as follows:

Inside and northerly, from a red painted post located at the southeastern tip of the Barbara G. Johnson property (Town of Brunswick Tax Assessor's Map 43 Lot 10), then southwest to the green Coast Guard channel buoy #15 located in the New Meadows River, then west to a red Coast Guard channel buoy #14 located in the New Meadows River, then northerly to a red painted post located at the southern tip of the Beverly Ouellette property (Town of Brunswick Tax Assessor's Map 39 Lot 20).

This closure restricts the harvest of Soft-Shell Clams, Quahogs and all species of Oysters, from the inter-tidal zone in and around Thomas Point Beach from May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015 to a date to be determined in the future.
