

Thomas Point Beach Conservation Closure

Effective Immediately, for the purpose of resource conservation it shall be unlawful to dig, take or possess Soft-Shell Clams (*Mya arenaria*), Quahogs (*Mercenaria mercenaria*), Razor Clams (*Ensis directus*), American and European Oysters, taken from within the coastal waters of Brunswick, Cumberland County, State of Maine with the following boundaries; From a red painted post located at the North East corner of the Thomas Point Beach stairs, running 300 feet along the shore/beach to another red painted post, hence easterly across the bay following the natural breakwater to another red painted post, then running 200 feet along the woods line to another red painted post, hence running westerly across the bay to the north east corner of the Thomas Point
