Board Composition.

Davis Fund Committee consists of seven (7) members who are appointed by the Town Council.

Term of Office.

The term of office is three (3) years.

Meeting Schedule.

Annually in May.

Powers and Duties.

The Nathaniel Davis Fund derives its income from a bequest made to the town by Samuel Gross Davis in memory of his father, Nathaniel Davis. Nathaniel Davis was born in 1791, “a substantial and useful citizen, the proprietor of a stationery store on Mason Street from 1825 until his death in 1866.”

The income from this bequest, known as the Nathaniel Davis Fund, shall be used each year for the “pleasure of its inhabitants as the government of Brunswick of that year shall decide.”

The Davis Fund Committee is charged with the responsibility of recommending projects which the committee feels most clearly fit the terms of the will to the Town Council. The committee meets with representatives of each organization requesting funds and makes recommendations to the Town Council.
