

**BRUNSWICK CONSERVATION COMMISSION
AUGUST 12, 2015**

A meeting of the Brunswick Conservation Commission was held on Wednesday, August 12, 2015 in Council Chambers, 85 Union Street, 1st Floor. Chair Amanda Bunker called the meeting to order at 4:30P.M.

a) Follow-up items

1) Mare Brook Watershed Management Plan grant application: Anna Breinich stated that the Town was awarded the grant through the Maine Coastal Communities Program and the Town Council has accepted this grant. Anna stated that a request for qualifications is being worked on and hoping to get it out as soon as possible.

3. Development Review

a) Rose Douglas Village Subdivision Presentation: Anna Breinich reviewed the materials included in the packet. Anna stated that staff is suggesting a site walk and noted that the proposed open space has not yet been delineated or finalized. Anna said that one concern is connectivity. Sandy Stott clarified that the conservation area proposed does meet the requirements even if the area being detained by the owner is not included. Amanda Bunker stated that in terms of the open space area, since it is abutting 2 Echo which is already being monitored, there is some sense in keeping similar monitoring next to each other. Kurt Stinson added that this also abuts the Woodpond conservation area. Anna said that this may be an area that BTLT becomes interested in. Kurt suggested that the easements be reviewed for similar language. Anna to schedule a site walk.
