Board Composition.

The Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee consists of seven (7) members who are appointed by the Town Council.

Terms of Office.

There is no set term.

Meeting Schedule.

Monthly – 3rd Thursday at 6:00 p.m.

Powers and Duties.

To advocate and work toward improving the bicycle and pedestrian network in Brunswick.

1. Using the “Brunswick Bicycle and Pedestrian Improvement Plan” as a tool working with a variety of groups to prepare an annual schedule of improvements to be included in the Capital Improvement Plan (CIP).
2. Seek alternative funding sources.
3. Act as an information source for Town officials and the community; keep in touch with what is going on regionally and nationally; share information as needed with other communities.
4. Make recommendations as warranted on proposed projects requiring development review by the Planning Board.
