Charges have been filed against Stephen L. McIntire (Age 55 of Bath) for six counts of the Class D Crime of Violation of Privacy (17-A MRS §511). The charges result from an investigation into multiple “peeping tom” complaints in the Bowdoin College neighborhood last Fall.

McIntire is currently being held at Two Bridges Regional Jail in Wiscasset on unrelated charges.

The new charges are based upon nonconsensual videos of adults inside their residences that were captured through windows. Some residences were off-campus and some were on campus. All identifiable individuals who were videotaped have been notified, but out of concern for the victims we will not release further descriptions.

An investigation of the Bath Police Department into an unrelated incident yielded a lead which assisted us with the investigation. Assistance was also supplied by Bowdoin College Safety and Security, the Maine Department of Corrections and the Maine Computer Crimes Task Force. We are grateful for the assistance of all four agencies.

Last Fall’s “peeping tom” incidents as well as the reported sexual assault on Belmont Street and two other reported incidents on Potter and Longfellow Streets are concerning but atypical for Brunswick. Considerable resources have been and continue to be employed to investigate these cases.
