PUBLIC NOTICE

The Town of Brunswick will be issuing Resident Commercial and Nonresident Commercial Shellfish licenses for the year 2018-2019. Licensing will follow the selection process contained in Section 11-140 of the Marine Activities, Structures and Ways Ordinance. The selection process for Residents is based upon the number of Resident Commercial Licenses held in the last ten years. The selection process for Nonresidents is based upon the number of Nonresident Commercial Licenses held in the last ten years. A list of those qualifying for the selection process is posted at the Town Clerk's Office. The commercial harvester must produce two pieces of acceptable identification showing current residence address. The Notice of Intent (application) for commercial shellfish license is available at the Town Clerk's Office. The commercial harvester must deliver the Notice of Intent to the Town Clerk's Office, in person, no later than the second Friday in March, which is March 9th, at 3:00 p.m. 2018. If an applicant misses the deadline, they can file a letter of intent until the 3rd Friday in March, March 16th, 2018, by paying a late fee of \$600, or \$400 for a bushel license

The Brunswick Town Clerk will begin issuing licenses on Wednesday, April 4, 2018, at 8:30 a.m.

Student Notices of Intent (application) will be available on Friday, April 6, 2018 and must be returned by Friday, May 4, 2018. Licensing will follow the selection process contained in Section 11-140 of the Marine Activities, Structures and Ways Ordinance. The selection process will be by lottery on Friday, May 11, 2018 at 2:30 pm, if there are more applicants than licenses available. If there are enough Student Licenses available and no lottery is necessary, the licenses may be purchased between May 7, and May 18, 2018.

Resident Recreational Licenses will be issued by the Brunswick Town Clerk beginning Monday, April 2, 2018. Ten percent of the number of Resident Recreational Licenses issued will be issued to non-residents.
