Please join the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Maine Department of Transportation (MaineDOT) at a public meeting regarding the Environmental Assessment for the Frank J. Wood Bridge (#2016) which carries Route 201 over the Androscoggin River on the Brunswick-Topsham town line. For the last several months, the agencies have been evaluating and receiving input on a number of alternatives as required by the National Environmental Policy Act. FHWA and MaineDOT now seek public input regarding the Environmental Assessment.

Representatives of FHWA and MaineDOT will be present on Wednesday, March 28, 2018 from 6:00pm to 8:00pm at the Mt Ararat High School Commons. The meeting will begin with a brief presentation introducing the project and the Environmental Assessment. MaineDOT and FHWA staff will be available to listen to concerns, receive comments, and answer questions. Anyone with an interest is invited to attend and participate in the meeting.

Accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities. Auxiliary aids will be provided upon advanced request.
