

The Town of Brunswick is seeking public input for updating the 2004 Village Review Overlay Zone (VRZ) Design Guidelines

Please join the Village Review Board, the Department of Planning and Development staff, and Barba + Wheelock for a **neighborhood meeting to consider updates to the VRZ Design Guidelines on Wednesday, April 4, 2018, 6:30 p.m. at the Curtis Memorial Library**

Proposed changes are anticipated to focus on new construction, additions, siding and trim, windows, porches, ramps and stairs, demolition, demolition delay, demolition by neglect, and criteria to expand the Village Review Zone.

Portions of the following streets are within the Village Review Overlay Zone (as shown):

Pleasant Street, **Cushing Street**, Oak Street, **High Street**, Cumberland Street, **Dunning Street**, Mill Street, **Bow Street**, Union Street, **Lincoln Street**, Town Hall Place, **Middle Street**, Elm Street, **Noble Street**, Railroad Avenue, **Mason Street**, Dunlap Street, **Bank Street**, Center Street, **Maine Street**, Park Row, **Fitch Place**, Cleveland Street, **Green Street**, Federal Street, **Franklin Street**, School Street, **Jordan Avenue**, Market Lane, **Maple Street**, and Bath Road.
