## Union Street Traffic Alert: Construction Continues:

The anticipated schedule for the period of August 16<sup>th</sup> to August 24<sup>th</sup> is as follows:

1. Union Street will continue to be closed in sections from Mill Street to the Municipal Lot during this period
2. There will continue to be periodic lane closures on Pleasant Street
3. The contractor will continue to fine grade sidewalks, driveways, and side streets
4. **Mill Street is scheduled to be paved this Friday August 17<sup>th</sup>, due to the width of Mill Street at Maine Street, Mill Street will need to be closed during paving.**
5. **Union Street and Pleasant Street are scheduled to be paved the week of August 20<sup>th</sup> detours will be implemented during paving operations.**
6. Union Street will be closed in various locations during work hours and will reopen to limited local access outside of work hours (generally work hours will be 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., M-F). No parking in the closed area will be allowed at any time during the estimated two week work period for this section.
