Town of Brunswick, Maine Street Lighting Committee

Background. The Town's adopted Capital Improvement Program (CIP) contains a project that would replace the street lighting currently rented from Central Maine Power (CMP) with LED lighting. In June of 2020, the Town Council funded the first phase of the project to acquire the existing rental lights from CMP. The second phase of the project would be to install LED lights to be owned and maintained by the Town.

In replacing the lights there will be several considerations that will need to be addressed by a street lighting policy. Among the considerations are locations, color temperature of the lights, lumens, fixture styles, and street light controls. A committee shall be created to assist the Town Manager and staff in developing a lighting policy and related recommendations to be considered by the Town Council for implementation.

Committee Members. The committee shall be comprised of the following eleven (11) members:

- Assistant Town Manager
- Town Engineer
- Public Works Director
- Director of Planning and Development
- Police Chief or Designee
- Two members of the Town Council as appointed by the Council Chair
- One member from each of the following as selected by the board or committee:
 - Planning Board
 - Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee
 - Recycling and Sustainability
 - Downtown Master Plan Implementation Committee

Committee's Scope of Work.

The committee shall assist in the following:

- Inventory of existing street lights owned or rented by the Town
- Development of a Street Lighting Policy for consideration by the Town Council
- Recommending the style, type, color temperature of the LED fixtures
- Evaluating and recommending whether additional features and controls are desirable and if so at what locations
- Evaluating vendor proposals and recommending selection
- Developing any other recommendations the Committee believes to be relevant

Reporting. The Town Manager shall periodically report to the Town Council on project activities and progress.

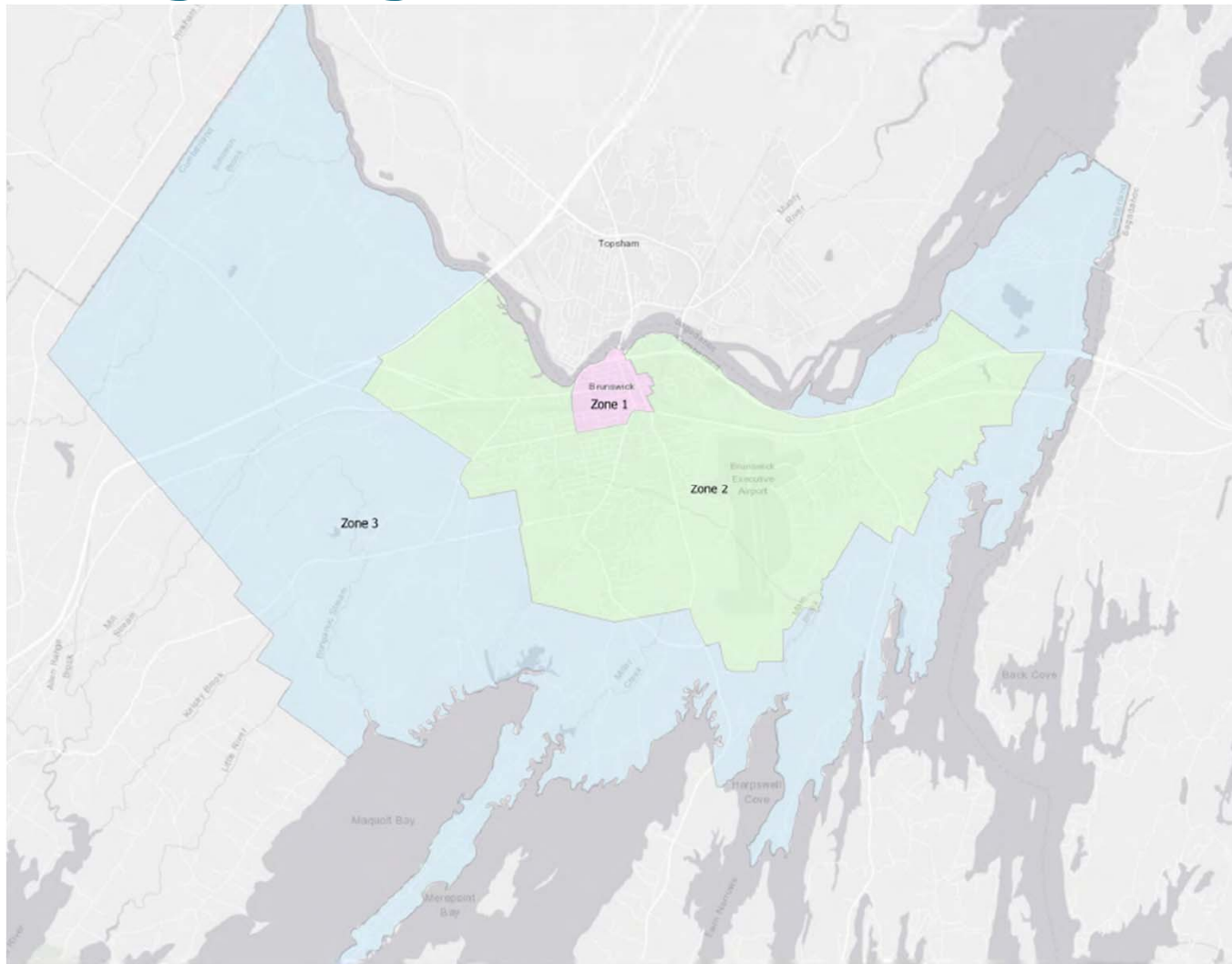
