- a. Last meeting – Unanimous vote to send a proposal to officially adopt the goat trails between points 24 and 29 **pending Dennis confirming a need for DEP inspection or not**
- b. Align on final recommendations for trail usage
 - i. Pedestrian/Limited Use
 - 1. 12 through 13 to Monument E
 - 2. 9 through 10 or 11 until the trails are improved or seasonal as these trails can be very wet or flooded
 - 3. 1 through 4 and 4 through 24 (Johnny's Trail and access to parking area) as they are narrow and there are safety concerns with blind corners
 - ii. All other trails multi-use

4. General Maintenance Priority Items

- a. Fix/replace broken trail signs (*Committee to approve*)
- b. Harden wet spots on trails
- c. Clean dump debris
- d. Remove poison ivy
- e. Restore American chestnut trees – ongoing, can remove unwanted small trees/shrubs in the wintertime.
- f. Replace dead tricentennial trees – *will happen this fall*
- g. Remove invading white pines from pitch pines – *ongoing in the winter*
