NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Town Council will hold a public hearing on Monday, October 4, 2021, at 6:30 p.m. in the Town Council Chambers of the Brunswick Town Hall, 85 Union Street to consider the following:

Item 1. The Town Council will hear public comments regarding an amendment to section 15-74 of the Municipal Code of Ordinances that would add a “No Parking” restriction on the north side of Pleasant Street between Mill Street and Interstate 295, and will take any appropriate action. (Councilor Kathy Wilson)

Item 2. The Town Council will hear public comments regarding adjusting the fees charged at the Graham Road Processing Facility, and will take any appropriate action. (Finance Committee)

- The fee change is for tree and brush waste/minimum charge going from \$10/\$5 lowered to \$5/\$2.50

The text of the proposed/adopted ordinance is too extensive to be included with this notice.
