Maine Summit Basketball League

The Brunswick Parks & Recreation Department will enter 5th grade boys and girls teams, along with separate 6th grade boys' and girls' teams in the Maine Summit Basketball League. Play will begin on the weekend of Nov 16th and conclude in March. All games will be played on either Saturday or Sunday. Playoffs will take place in late February with championships the following weeks. Practices (one or two per week) will be scheduled weeknights at the Recreation Center and/or the Harriet Beecher Stowe School. Player flexibility is needed. *Players who are selected for this league will be assessed a fee of \$110 to offset league entry, uniforms and other expenses.* Try-out dates and times are listed below. It is **mandatory** for players to attend the tryouts.

Transportation to and from games will be the responsibility of parents. Parents willing to car-pool must furnish the Parks and Recreation Department with a copy of their driver's license, vehicle registration, and proof of insurance.

Uniforms will be assigned to registered players prior to the first game. Players who have not registered and paid are not eligible to play, and will not be assigned a uniform until they do so.

THIS WILL BE THE ONLY TRAVEL BASKETBALL PROGRAM OFFERED THIS YEAR FOR 5TH/6TH GRADE. THERE WILL BE NO POST-SEASON TRAVEL TEAMS SELECTED AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE DEPARTMENT'S IN-HOUSE 5TH AND 6TH GRADE WINTER LEAGUE.
