This winter the Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department will be offering **one 6-week session** of the Teen Hip Hop/ Jazz Dance Combo for Jr. high school students in grades 6-8. **The fee per participant is \$75.00 for Brunswick Residents and \$99.00 for Non-Residents.** The session will run from **January 6th- February 24th, however, classes will not be held on January 20th and February 17th due to holiday closures.** Once again, this program will be offered at the Brunswick Junior High School as well.

This class involves a fusion of two styles, jazz and hip-hop. Jazz is fun, upbeat and is based in ballet, while hip-hop is known for riding the beat of the music in creative and interesting ways. The resulting combination is both hard-hitting and emotionally compelling. Students should bring water to class and wear flexible comfortable clothing. There will be an opportunity to perform at the end of each session, so attendance is required. Come ready to learn and work as a team!

Transportation will not be provided as it takes place right after school. Students should have rides available at the end of their session. Additionally, participants who are not students at Brunswick Junior High School will be responsible for getting to the Jr. High School for their dance session.

Classes will be taught by Instructor Kate Andreu.

Kate has been in the performing arts industry for 17 years working on numerous performance and production projects all over the state. She is a USM alumna with a BS in social work and minor in dance. She choreographed for Dance USM 5 years in a row and has been asked back by Professor Maria Tzianabos to guest teach in the USM dance program. She is a former dance studio owner and currently works as a professional choreographer and consultant. She has successfully designed and implemented dance enrichment programs, master classes and workshops in Portland, Freeport, and greater Midcoast areas. Kate is a well-known performing arts professional with an energy level to match. She looks forward to engaging with her students and helping them find a love of dance and performance!

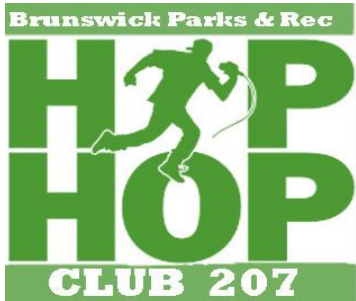
