Brunswick Issues Emergency Order

Also Extends Tax Due Date to May 15th

Brunswick, Maine USA – March 24, 2020

The Town of Brunswick has issued an Emergency Proclamation and Order prohibiting large gatherings, and limiting in-person business transactions. The Order closes any establishments that sell or otherwise provide goods or services, unless it meets one of twenty-nine listed exemptions or it is a food establishment providing take-out or delivery service. The Order can be viewed at the Town's website at www.brunswickme.org.

The Town Council also voted to extend the property tax due date by one month to May 15th. The Town Council recognizes that individuals and families are struggling financially and this change is aimed at providing some measure of relief.

The Town has also lifted its ban on single-use plastic bags. While the Town encourages the use of paper bags, stores may use plastic until further notice. Officials report that some customers and employees are concerned about cross contamination with the use of reusable bags.
