In 1932, the Nathaniel Davis Fund was established by a bequest in the Will of Samuel Gross Davis in memory of his father, Nathaniel. The income of the fund is to be used for the “pleasure of its inhabitants as the government of Brunswick that year shall decide.” Therefore, in order to be considered, this application must conform to the terms of the bequest. The Committee will consider, among other things, the extent to which the funding is expected to bring pleasure to the inhabitants of Brunswick, number of Brunswick people impacted, the time of year of the project and other available sources of funding to the group.

You will be notified by US mail and by email of the time and place for one representative only to appear before the Committee to present this application. **We anticipate that the Committee will be meeting by Zoom in 2021.** *If by May 1, you have not heard when you are scheduled to present, you are responsible for contacting the Town Manager's office at 207-725-6659 for an appointment. Failure to meet with the Committee will result in your application being automatically denied.*

When the project is completed, but no later than April 1, 2022, grantees are required to submit a brief status report including how and when the grant was spent, approximately how many people participated or were impacted, and how the contribution of the Davis Fund was publicized

If due to circumstances, the funds are not spent for the project for which you apply, you are to return the unused funds before June 30, 2022, so that that they can be redistributed by the Nathaniel Davis Fund.
