- Cubic yard is measured as 3' wide x 3' long x 3' high.
- Minimum charge is \$5.00 residential and \$10.00 commercial.
- Credit Card/Cash/Check accepted for payment.
- Materials **not accepted** at this facility include trash, recycling (cardboard/paper/plastic/glass), asphalt shingles, concrete, used motor oil, and hazardous waste.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Does the landfill closing affect what I can put curbside for weekly collection?

No, the closing of the Graham Road landfill does not affect your weekly curbside collection of trash and recycling.

What materials will you continue to accept at Graham Road?

We will continue to accept clean wood waste, brush, leaves, grass, scrap metal, white goods, tires, electronic waste, and universal waste.

We will not accept trash, recycling (cardboard, paper, plastic, glass), asphalt shingles, concrete/masonry, used motor oil, and hazardous waste.

Where is the processing facility?

The processing facility is located next to the landfill at 49 Graham Road.

Are the hours of operation remaining the same?

No, the hours of operation will be Friday and Saturday, 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM, year-round. We do anticipate expanding the number of days it is open during peak weeks in spring and fall, and we will publicize this information in advance of the temporary schedule changes.

Do I still need to buy an annual permit?

Yes, a residential or commercial permit will still be required to utilize the processing facility. The price is \$5 for a residential permit and \$25 for a commercial permit. Existing 2021 permit holders will not need to purchase a new permit; existing permits will be honored.

Are the prices remaining the same for the materials?

No, the fee schedule for materials and items has changed. Please refer to the updated fee schedule for detailed information.

Will you finally be able to accept credit cards for payment?

Absolutely! Credit cards, cash, and check will be accepted for payment.

I used to bring my bulky trash that is not allowed curbside to the landfill. How should I dispose of those items like chairs, couches, mattresses, and carpets?

Residents and businesses can dispose their bulky waste at the Pine Tree Waste/Casella transfer station in West Bath (64 Arthur J. Reno Road, off Bath Road). The Pine Tree facility accepts trash, recycling, construction and demolition debris, electronic waste, and universal waste. No permit is necessary, but you will be charged a fee based on the type and weight of your material(s). (See Attached Fee Schedule)
