

A CALL TO MAINE ARTISTS REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

ART AROUND TOWN: *BRUNSWICK TREE NURSERY*

ISSUE DATE: 6/25/2021

SUMMARY OF PROJECT:

To work with children from Family Focus to create a three “mini-murals” for the Town of Brunswick’s new Tree Nursery. The mini-murals should have environmental themes around sustainability, nature, and trees.

This project is administered by Brunswick Public Art in partnership with Brunswick Downtown Association, Family Focus, and Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department.

ARTIST COMPENSATION:

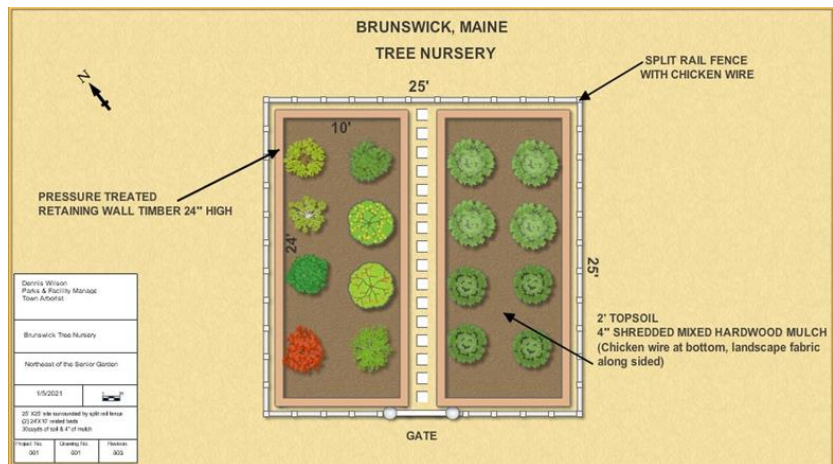
The selected artist will receive a \$1,200 stipend. Additionally, the artist will be reimbursed up to \$250 for materials.

SITE SPECIFICATIONS:

Three (3) 4’ x 3’ plywood boards.

Two painted plywood boards will be installed on two sides of the tree nursery. One will be given to Family Focus for their walls.

To the right is a sketch of the Tree Nursery located on Industry Way in Brunswick. (The nursery will be under construction this summer and complete by Sept.)



TIMELINE & SUBMISSION:

The proposal should include a description of the process working with Family Focus, experience working with kids, and general description of final product. Sketches are welcomed. Please include details on materials to be used and timeline, including work sessions with children.

The Review Committee will review all proposals and notify applicants by July 23, 2021.
The project should commence no later than September 1, 2021 and be complete by October 31, 2021.
