

Town Commons Trail System

P Parking for Town Commons is on Rt. 123, south 1.6 miles from intersection of Federal Street and Bath Road. Parking also available at Farley Field House to access beginning of trail corridor.

Trail Access Points

Route 123 – Parking and picnic area

Bowdoin St – Enter at end of street

Meadowbrook Rd – End of street,

Alder Road – Trail begins at end of street, cross stream, bear left, up hill

Cushnoc Ln – Corner with Amokegan

Melden Dr. – Access at end of road

Middle Bay Road – Park on Pennelville then walk to trail

Beech Dr. – Trail at end of cul de sac; bear right and down slope

Baxter Ln – Trail corridor narrows through this neighborhood; please respect homeowners; keep dogs on leash

Trails

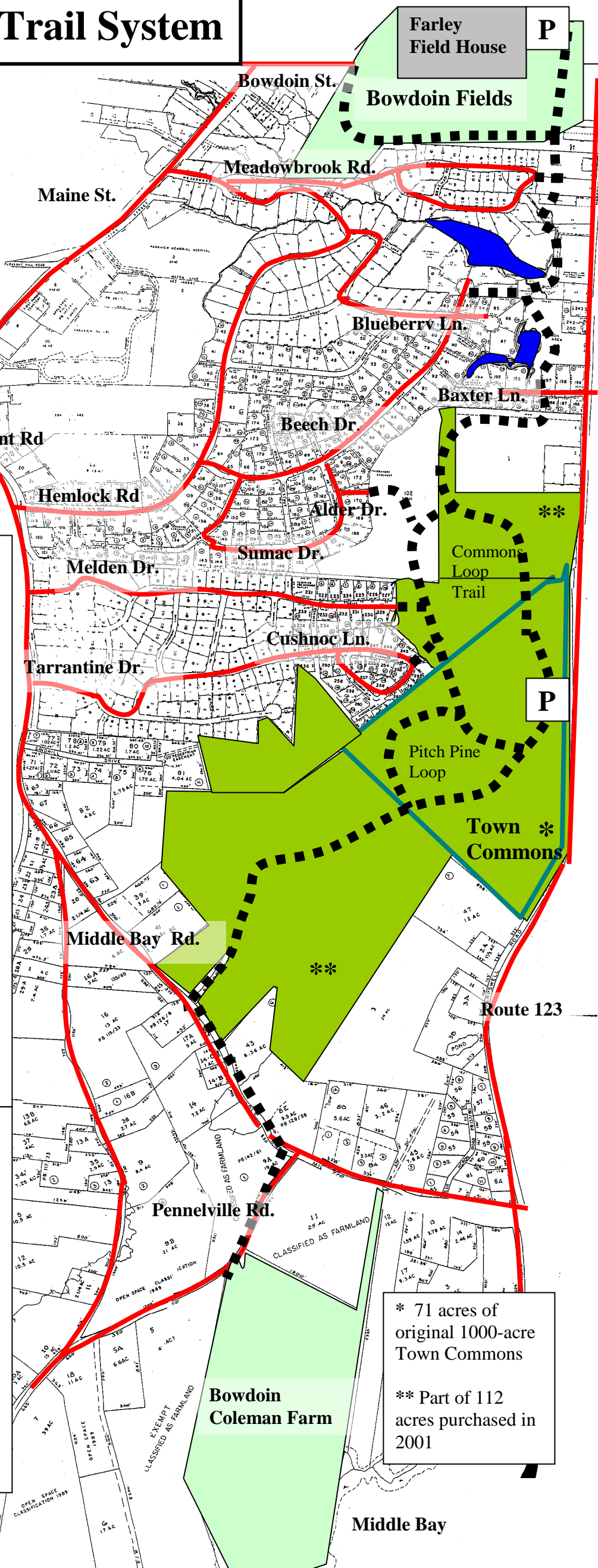
Bowdoin to Middle Bay Rd – 5 miles round-trip; allow 1½ - 2 hrs.

Commons Loop Trail – Allow 45min

Pitch Pine Loop – Allow 20-30min.

Coleman Farm – Trail not currently marked; will be developed in near future; current access requires traversing cow pasture to access dirt road that connects to overlook of Middle Bay; alternate route to bay: follow Pennelville Rd to end at Barnes Landing
