This is a soccer program for youth who experience disabilities of physical, social, communicative, and/or cognitive challenges! Children participating in the program will be supported by a parent or guardian familiar with the child (at least 18 years old) and will work together with the assistance of an instructor and other volunteers to learn the basics of soccer.

Each skill is broken down into simple steps so kids and adults have a framework to teach and learn. Youth will make individualized improvements, but will also have opportunities to bring their physical and social individualized improvements together, working as a team and building relationships, all while having fun! One on one attention means each class is tailored specifically to your child's needs and progress. Regular sneakers are acceptable for this program and each child will receive a t-shirt and a soccer ball!
